EJI is launching a program to provide direct healthcare services to people transitioning out of Alabama state prisons. EJI believes that access to high quality healthcare is essential to reducing poverty and is a basic human right. Furthermore, access to behavioral health services and treatment for chronic disease can have a large impact on the likelihood of a successful re-entry and can reduce recidivism and promote public safety.

What services do we offer?

- Consultation with a physician with full medical history and physical exam
- Review of previous health records and medications
- Point of care basic laboratory tests to screen for diabetes, high cholesterol, anemia, HIV and HCV and can evaluate electrolytes, kidney disease and liver function
- Refills and basic prescription medications
